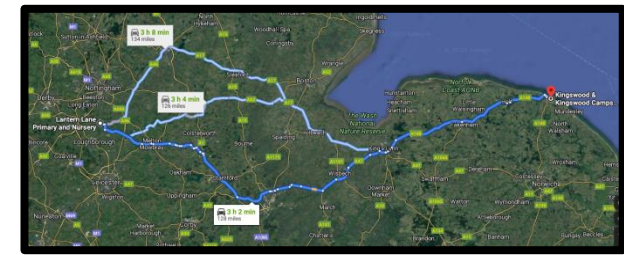


Should I stay (in East Leake) or should I go (to Norfolk)?

An investigation into contrasting localities.



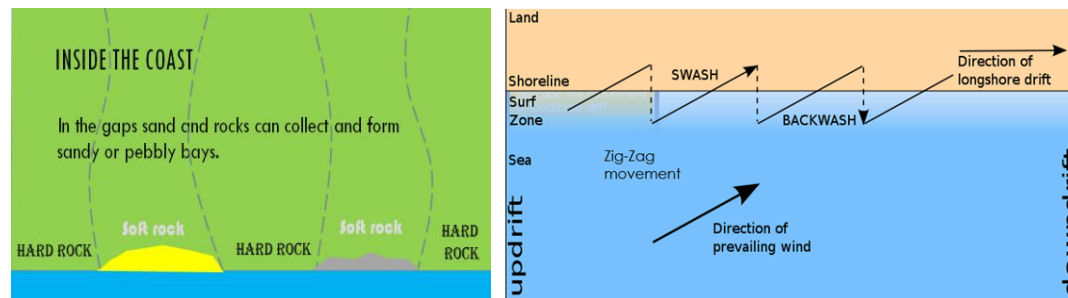
Comparing and Contrasting East Leake and Overstrand (Norfolk Coast)

	Similarities	Differences
Physical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Surrounded by fields and farms. -Land is fairly flat and so suited to farming. -Little woodland nearby. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Overstrand has a coast. -Overstrand has cliffs. -Overstrand has erosion defences. -East Leake has a brook that runs through it. -East Leake is surrounded by land.
Human	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Farming a large employer. -Limited access in terms of main roads. -Area of land taken up by the village. -Larger town nearby. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -East Leake has a larger permanent population. -East Leake has more convenience stores. -East Leake has larger schools and more schools. -Overstrand has more hotels and campsites. -Overstrand more leisure activities available.

Key Word	Definition
Compass	A device to orient a person.
Grid Reference - 4 and 6	A system to find places on a map.
OS Map	Detailed maps of an area.
Cartographers	People who draw maps.
Northings	Y axis of an OS Map.
Eastings	X axis of an OS Map.
Scale	A way to measure distances on a map.
Relief	The part of the map that shows the physical make up of a place.
Contour Lines	Lines which show how steep and high the land is of an area.
Route	The directions to take in order to reach a destination.
Scenic	Views of impressive or beautiful natural scenery.

Key Word	Definition
Erosion	Destruction of a natural feature.
Long Shore Drift	The movement of material (sediment) along the coastline.
Groynes	A longshore drift defence that catches sediment to keep it in place.
