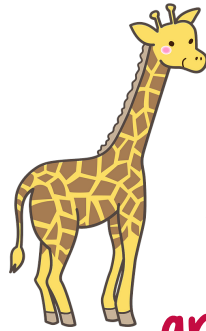
The weather in Africa is hot and dry.
