## Key vocabulary and definitions

**Bonfire Night-** Bonfire Night is celebrated on 5th November of every year.

**Guy Fawkes-** A man who tried to blow up the houses of parliament because he thought that the government were treating Roman Catholics unfairly.

**Fire Safety Rules** - What we need to do around fireworks/ bonfires to keep safe.

**Remembrance Day** Remembrance Day (in Australia, Canada, and the United Kingdom) is a day to remember people who fought and died in wars.

**Diwali-** Diwali is the Hindu festival of lights

**Rama and Sita-** A good man, called Rama, was married to a beautiful princess, called Sita. One of the main stories in Hinduism.

**Hinduism-**a religion that lots of people follow

**Winter-** In winter, the weather is much colder. Sometimes it is cold enough to freeze, leaving frost and ice on the ground. It sometimes snows. Many trees have bare branches as all their leaves have fallen off. The daytimes are the shortest in the year and the night times are the longest.

**Ice-** frozen water

**Arctic-** relating to the regions around the North Pole.
