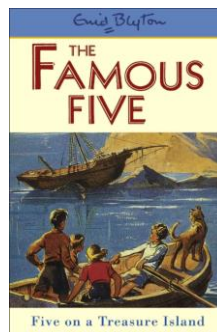

Key Vocabulary

personality	The combination of characteristics or qualities that makes someone's individual character.
self-esteem	Confidence in one's own worth or abilities; self-respect.
confidence	A feeling of self-assurance that comes from appreciating one's own abilities or qualities.
acceptance	A willingness to tolerate differences.
loneliness	The fact of being without friends.
disappointment	A sadness or unhappiness caused by not meeting one's hopes or expectations.
compromise	An agreement of a dispute that is made by both sides making concessions.
adventure	An unusual and exciting or daring experience; an excitement linked to danger or taking risks.
historical	Events and behaviour based on the way things were done, or set in the past.
