Good Early Years Attendance = Best Chances of Success

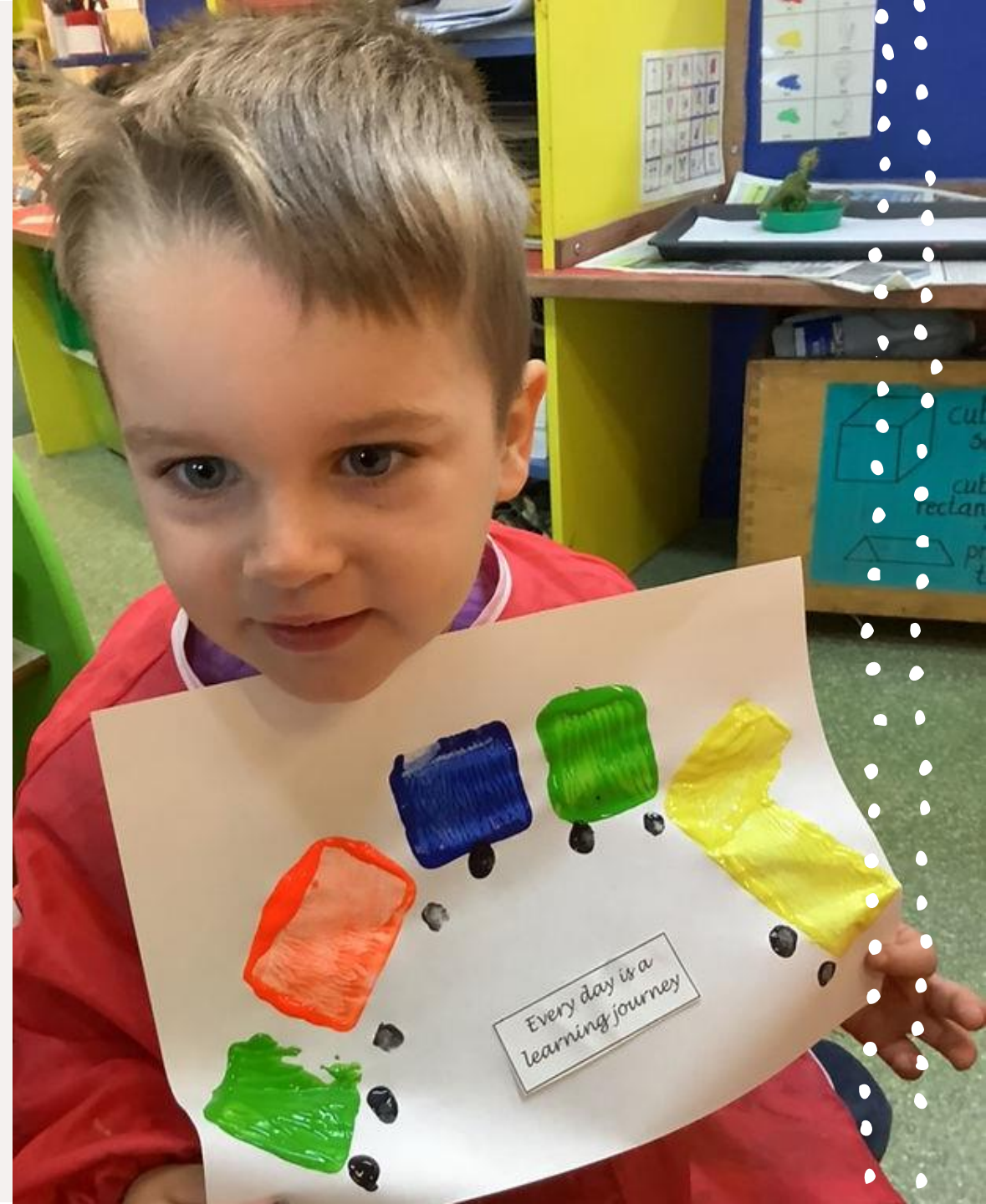
It might not be compulsory, but there are lots of reasons why it's important your child has good attendance at our nursery.



It's more than play...

Your child will develop:

- social skills, independence and self-regulation.
- early reading, counting and communication skills.



A happy start...

- Having a good routine helps your child feel safe and secure.
- Coming to every session means your child gets to know the adults and children in nursery and around school.
- Being at nursery regularly helps children feel part of our nursery & school community.



A head start...

- Getting into good habits for coming to school every day, on time.
- Children who attend our nursery regularly settle quickly & make good progress with learning in Reception.
- When we know children well, we can make sure that they have the help and support they need more quickly.

Good for you!

Good attendance means that:

- We get to know you and your child well and can celebrate their achievements together.
- You can talk to us about any concerns about your child's development or things which might affect them.
- We can help you with local support, advice and ideas about your child's learning, routines and behaviour.
- You can get ideas to support your child's behaviour and learning at home, and different places or activities you could take them to.

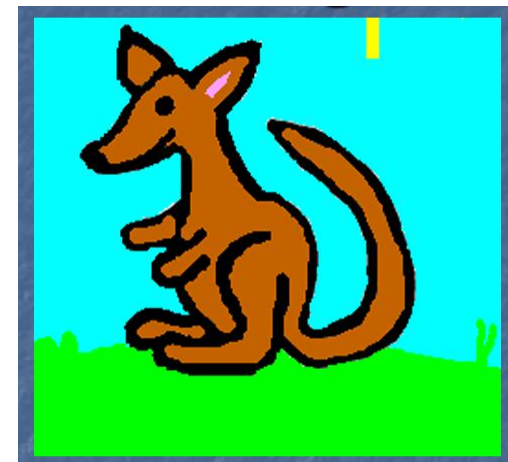
On time, every time

- Coming to nursery on time gives your child the best start to the day.
- No-one likes coming into a room late – it can make children feel worried and unsettled.



Is it a problem?

- Children who regularly miss sessions or are generally late, can frequently experience a sense of having to try a little bit harder just to understand what is going on and what other children are talking about or doing.
- Friendships are hard for children to maintain when they don't attend regularly.
