Lantern Lane Home - School Agreement

School will:

- Ensure we do everything we can to make sure children are in school every day with good attendance rewarded and absences accounted for.
- Provide a safe environment for your child and work with parents and carers to ensure pupils are safe and free from harm and abuse.
- Set regular homework for pupils and tell you how they can help at home.
- Provide a balanced curriculum of the highest quality and meet the individual needs of every child.
- Listen to any concerns you or your child may have and do our best to address them swiftly.
- Talk to you about any issues your child may have in school and work in partnership to improve areas of concern.
- Provide opportunities for parents/carers to be involved in school life and provide information online and letters home.
- Have a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children.

Parents and carers will:

- Send my child to school every day, on time, unless they are too unwell to come, in their school uniform with everything they need.
- Inform the school of any absences from school and try to make medical appointments for my child outside school time. Avoid days off for holiday.
- Support my child with homework and reading regularly at home. .
- Talk to my child about the school day and encourage them to try their best.
- Talk to staff about anything that might affect my child's ability to learn or behave well.
- Share any concerns or complaints with school staff directly and away from children, following our complaints procedure.
- Support the school to make sure my child follows the school rules and encourage them to behave well.
- Do our best to attend parents/carers evenings and special events and read information sent home and online.

Pupils will:

- Come to school every day, on time, except when I'm too poorly.
- Read at home every day and do my homework.
- Bring all the equipment I need every day including my reading book and PE kit.
- Wear my school uniform with pride
- Talk to my parents/carers about school and share my learning with them.
- Work hard and listen carefully to instructions.
- Be polite, friendly and helpful to other children and all adults.
- Follow the school rules; behave well at all times.
- Tell somebody if there is something I am worried or unhappy about.
- Tell a trusted adult if I think someone is being bullied or picked on.
- Take good care of the school environment.
- Take letters home and invite my parents/carers to special events in school.
